The app works on smartphones running Android and iOS.

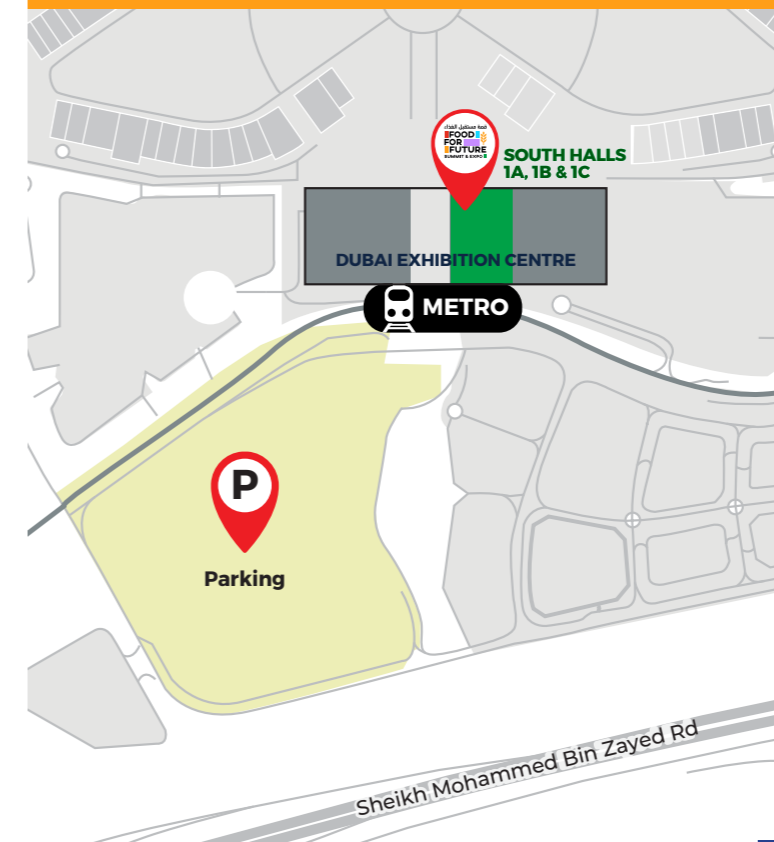
